The CM/UM Medical Director/Physician Advisor (PA) will lead the organization in appropriate resource utilization to meet regulatory as well as value based purchasing agreements. This physician will collaborate with the UM/CM departments to assure patients are managed in the most cost effective appropriate level of care and within regulatory requirements. This physician will collaborate with the data analytic team to develop resources utilization reports and assist in working directly with high utilizing providers to make appropriate practice pattern changes.

The CM/UM Medical Director/Physician Advisor (PA) will conduct clinical reviews on cases referred by the CM/UM staff and/or other health care professionals to assure cases meet regulatory requirements and are in accordance with the hospitals objectives for assuring quality patient care and effective, efficient utilization of health care services.

The CM/UM Medical Director/PA meets with UM/CM staff and health care team members to discuss selected cases and make recommendations for care, interacting with medical staff members and medical directors of third party payers to discuss the needs of patients and alternative levels of care. The Medical Director/PA acts as consultant to and resource for attending and hospitalist physicians regarding their decisions relative to appropriateness of hospitalization, continued stay, and use of resources. The Medical Director/PA further acts as a resource for the medical staff regarding federal and state utilization and quality regulations.
